Be the hero we need, come join us in our mission!

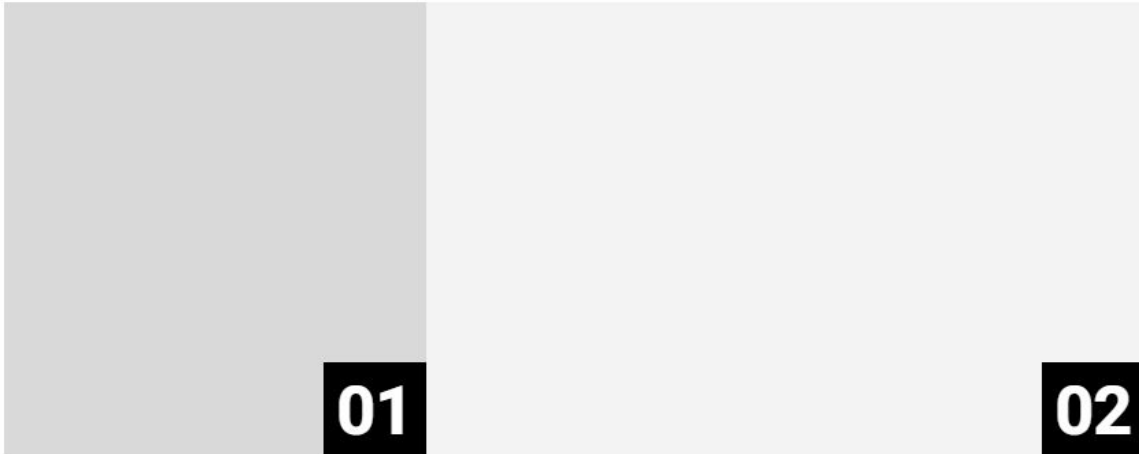

Our code guidelines for clients are available on <https://campuspress.com/docs/developers/>. Creating WordPress themes usually does not involve usage of code that might be bad for performance but it's good to have those guidelines in mind while working on this application. **What's really important for education clients is accessibility so please make everything follow all accessibility standards as much as possible.**

Your task will be to create a child theme for CampusPress Flex theme:

The goal of this theme will be to add a new custom block to the editor. To speed things up, please integrate it with the theme by using a plugin like "Genesis Custom Blocks":

If you are more comfortable with another tool that is similar to this, it's fine to use it instead as long as we can access it. On top of that, feel free to use any 3rd party scripts/libraries that can be beneficial for the project.

Below you can find the wireframe for the block. Please don't worry about spacing, sizes or animations. As long as it will look similar, it's fine. What is more important here is accessibility - please focus on that.

New block has exactly 2 items that include:

- Image (visible in place of grey background)
- Title (bold text at the beginning)
- Description (regular text after the title)
- Link (link for “Read More” button)

On the wireframe, item “02” is currently active but visitors can toggle between items by clicking on images (grey backgrounds). This action should expand the newly activated image, shrink the other one and toggle the content.
