In SLS we are frequently asked for some custom snippets. Following are some samples of what a simple request would look like. Try solving them and then add the custom snippet in your replies. No need to create any repository for those.

- 1. Install Forminator free version from WP org. Create a new Custom Form that will have a Name field and an Email field. We would need to allow only our staff to submit that form. Staff's email addresses have "incsub.com" as domain. We would need a custom snippet that would return the following error message "Only staff is allowed to use this form" when the email address has a different domain. For example "john@incsub.com" would pass but "john@hotmail.com" would fail and return the error message mentioned above.
- 2. Install Hustle free version from WP org. Create a new Pop-Up, it doesn't matter what type it is, Email Opt-in or Informational. You can choose any template from the options too, that won't matter either. Once done with the set up, in the Popup options, click on the Behaviour tab. Under the Pop-up Trigger section make sure the Render a new button option is active. From there copy the shortcode and place it in a page.

Now that the Pop-up is ready and the Shortcode is in place, when visiting the page that you placed the shortcode, you should see a link that when clicked will open the Pop-up. What we want is a js snippet that will hide that button once the Pop-up has been displayed. You would need to load that custom js snippet only in the page(s) that contains that shortcode.

3. While you still have Hustle installed, create a new Pop Up, again choose any type and template during setup. Allow this new Pop Up to load on every page load, which means just leave the default settings. However this will cause a problem to your previous page that has the shortcode, it will hide the Click link so your visitors won't be able to load the first Pop Up. How can you fix this?

Awesome, you've completed the tasks!

All you have to do is submit your application and wait for the team to get in contact. We'll aim to do this within 10-15 working days.
