1. Life is a pattern, and I'm just stacking my blocks!

Hello,

I'm working on a site that was built using the 2024 theme and I'm having troubles with patterns that I'm hoping you can help resolve.

I have this pattern created that is used at the bottom of some of my pages, basically it's just two columns, one should show the latest posts, and one should show oldest posts. So, I tried to do this myself, but I'm not familiar with block editor that much and I actually made things worse. Now the right column shows pages instead of posts and I have no idea why :(

Left column looks good, but I made a mess with the right one and I'm scared to touch it further.

I figured out that I can actually export/import patterns so I've uploaded an export file and was hoping that you can make the adjustments for me so I can import it back.

Here's an overview of what I need done:

- Content of both left and right column should look and behave exactly the same
- Left column should show 5 latest posts
- Right column should show 5 oldest posts
- Posts in left column should have light green background
- Posts in right column should have light red background

I am not sure why, but it doesn't show the Nickname, or anything really, even when testing with a default theme and no plugin enabled.

Can you please assist with fixing the code and point out my mistake?

Hi support,

Developer that worked on my site created a custom post type for me that I need to make some edits to.

Apparently it was done using a plugin called ACF, but it looks complicated and I'm not sure how I can make changes mentioned below.

- Change wording in admin - All book text is using plural values, so if you go to add new book it says "Add New Books", it should be "Add New Book"
- When I edit regular posts, I can get back to my previous edits by using Revisions that show in the sidebar while editing posts. I don't see this option for books, is it possible to add it?
- Can I have the Books menu item to be first in my admin section, above Dashboard? This is the main item I use on my site and I want it to be on top. Also, is it possible to change the icon from pin to a book?
- Is it possible to add something like categories for my Books? Same as the Posts have Categories, I would like to have Book Authors for book posts.

Oh yeah, I did figure out how I can export stuff from ACF. Can you make the edits and send me back a new file that I can then import?
